MSc Science and Technology Policy and Management

The ESRC Innogen Centre at the University of Edinburgh announces a new masters studentship for the academic year 2009/10. The studentship will provide support for a full-time student on either the *MSc Science and Technology Studies* or the *MSc Science and Technology Policy and Management*.

The studentship covers the costs of the University UK/EU fees for the one-year full-time course – £4,850 – plus £450 research expenses. Applications are invited from within or outside the European Union, but the studentship does not cover the full costs of fees for non-EU students.

The studentship holder must pursue study in either of the programmes *MSc Science and Technology Studies* or *MSc Science and Technology Policy and Management* in the School of Social and Political Science. Additionally, the student must undertake to follow the Life Sciences and Biotechnology specialist strand within either of these courses and complete a thesis on a related topic.
