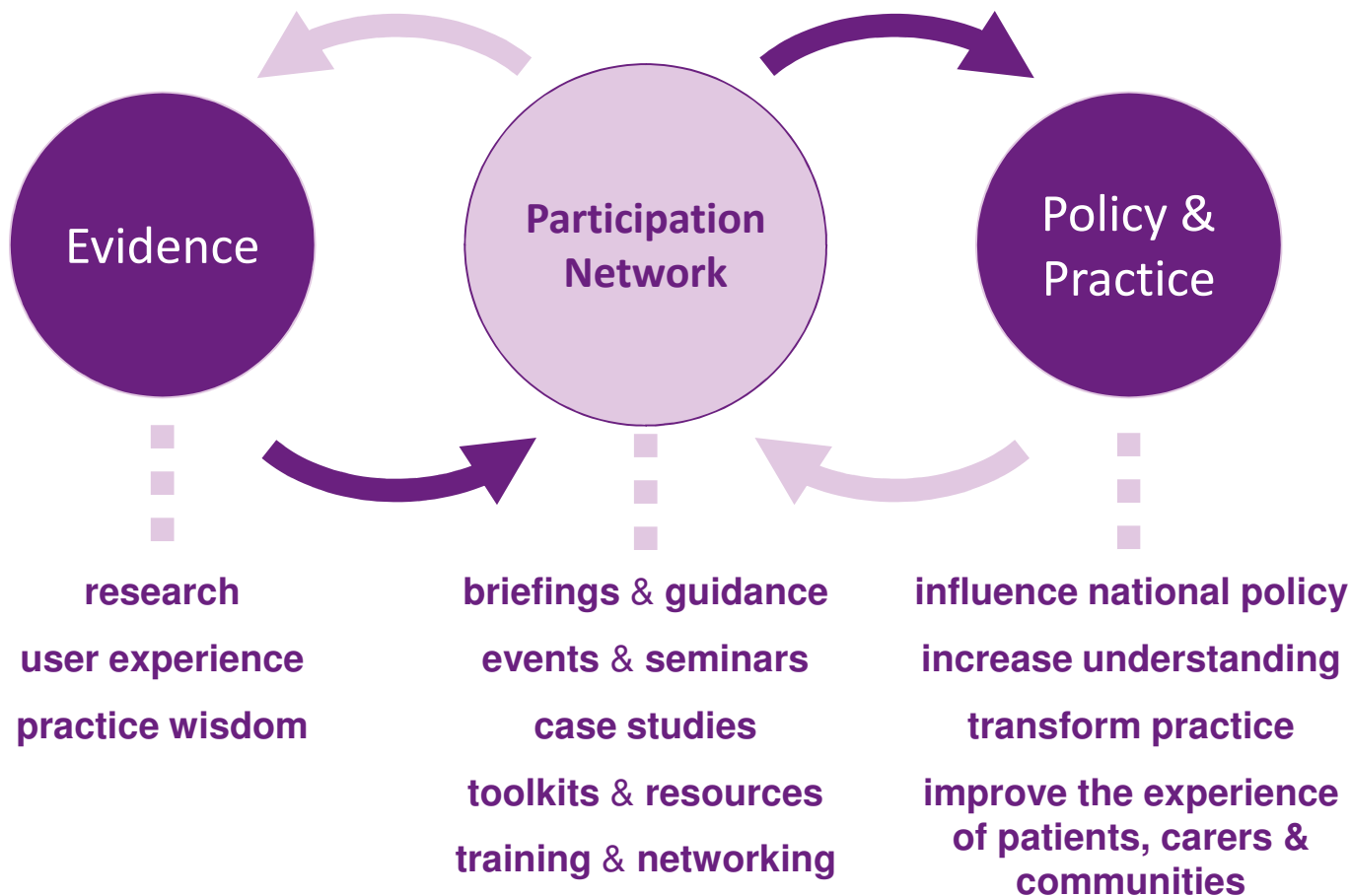


The Participation Network as Knowledge Broker
